Memorandum: Release all the Nepalese Political Prisoners in India

Your Excellency,

Since history, it is well known that Nepal and India has been sharing its bilateral harmonization as they have close ties in many aspects. As Nepal is situated between two massive countries India and China with their huge populations, your country naturally influences the politics of Nepal. It is absolutely clear that Nepal is passing through a birth pain of Democratic Republican system. The peoples of Nepal want to be free from the bondage of the 238-year feudal monarchism of Nepal. Your approach to propose the Nepalese Monarch to reinstate the democratic rights in Nepal after the ridiculous royal coup Feb 1 2005 was a moral support to the Nepalese People to strengthen their struggle against the Dictator.

After the 19 days mass uprising in April under the leadership of SPA and CPN (Maoist) and other forces, Nepalese people gave mandate to the Political parties to abolish the feudal monarchism in Nepal and to establish democratic republican system straight away. Nepalese People have stopped the movement just to see whether the political parties will function as People's wish or not. The verdict of the people is not to reinstate the old structures, which were already failure in the context of Nepal. They are demanding to sack all old state power and to form an interim constitution which will form an interim government including CPN (Maoist). The interim government will held and election of constituent assembly and Nepal will enter to the Democratic Republican System peacefully.

It is crystal clear that the 19 days mass uprising has been so powerful in the context of the people's war initiated by the CPN (Maoist) since 1996 to liberate Nepalese People from Feudalism and foreign domination. They have been fighting for the sovereignty of the Nepalese People. Because of their vision of new Nepal without exploitation and domination, Nepalese people have belief on them and they have been hoping some changes from them. For that Thirteen thousands people have given up their lives. Thousands have been disappeared by the Royal regime and thousands have imprisoned producing fake cases against them.

Hence, Liberation movement is not terrorism and sooner or later it is proved. After the 12 points understanding in November 2005 between CPN (Maoist) and SPA, Nepalese peoples came to the street thundering the old state and it was defeated.

Because of people's power the fake cases against the CPN (Maoist) and its activists have been discharged. 8 Points of agreement has been done between CPN (Maoist) and the Government which conforms that CPN (Maoist) is taking part in the interim Government of Nepal for the election of the constituent assembly.

In this context too, there are some senior leaders including Mohan Baidhya and C P Gajurel and activists of the CPN (Maoist) in the prisons of India under some fake accusations. It is unreasonable that the leaders of the people of one country can be threat to another country. So the continued detention of the leaders who have been spending their whole life to sovereign the people of Nepal from exploitation is totally inhuman, illegal and against the Universal code of conduct of Human Right.

So, through this memorandum we urge you to release the Nepalese political prisoners and others who have been accused in connections with freedom of the Nepalese people without conditions immediately and let them to involve in the process for the betterment of the future of the Nepalese People.
